Dear Mr. Gambito:

This pertains to your letter-complaint dated December 17, 2003, addressed to Honorable Karina C. David, Chairperson of the Civil Service Commission (CSC), requesting for an investigation with respect to the fund raising campaign of the Philippine Ports Authority (PPA) officials, in violation of Section 3(e) of Republic Act No. 3019.

Please be informed that on August 16, 2005, said letter-complaint was indorsed by the CSC to the Office of the President and the latter indorsed the same on September 6, 2005 to the Presidential Anti-Graft Commission (PAGC).

We have undertaken the initial evaluation on your letter-complaint and for PAGC to proceed to the investigation process, we are now requesting you to file a **written complaint under oath**, within fifteen (15) calendar days from receipt of this correspondence, specifically alleging and indicating therein the names of the persons complained of and the specific acts and/or omissions attributed to the said public officials which violates **R.A. No. 3019** and attaching therewith sworn statements of witnesses, papers and other documents in support of the charge(s) therein, if any. This requirement is in accordance with **Section 1, Rule II of the PAGC New Rules of Procedure**.
